**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

This is a budget amendment to an existing grant first approved by Council in 2018. There is no change to the scope of work or term length. This grant will provide \$362,968 for the Public Safety CORE team during State FY25. The CORE team is a primary response team that consists of a police officer, paramedic, and mental health clinician. They respond together to mental health calls for service. The team provides direct service on scene along with follow-up services, resource navigation, and referrals to the Public Safety Case Management Team as necessary. The CORE team is a key component of the Public Safety diversion model.
