## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

The State legislative season started on January 10, and the City Council asked for a regular update of their activities, particularly bringing any pending legislation with municipal impact to the Council for official opinion.

Any legislation that are brought to the City Council will be sent on the Friday prior to the Council meeting and will be posted in the designated posting areas at that time (north windows of the Civic Center and bulletin board outside of City Council Chambers) at least 24 hours prior to the meeting and on the City's website, where the public can also track all of the legislation that staff has identified:

The webpage also has the policies that guide the legislative process. Special attention will be paid to proposed legislation that tie to the Council Work Plan and will be brought to Council for official position if it would be of benefit or detriment to the plan.
