My name is Bruce Katuna and I am submitting an application for Longmont city council to offer my time and efforts to serve my community. My wife and I have lived (and mostly worked) in Longmont for nearly 35 years, raised two daughters here, both of whom attended Longmont High School (where one of them was a basketball star), and have long considered Longmont home.

My wife and I are both physicians, she an internist who transitioned first onto the executive team of Colorado Kaiser Permanente, and then into physician leadership coaching, and me a neurologist. I worked at the Longmont Clinic for 15 years and then in 2010 started my own company doing something called intraoperative neurophysiologic monitoring. I sold the company to neurologists in the company which I had previously hired, but stayed on as the company's chief financial officer, a position I currently hold. I have been retired from clinical medical practice for 5 years.

Since retiring from clinical practice I have had time to pursue hobbies, which include pickleball, chess, music, philosophy, reading, and travel. I have helped coach the girls and boys basketball programs at Longmont High School. I was head coach of the Longmont Lightning, a girls club basketball team, 20 years ago for 4 years and then again two years ago. I have worked on basketball skills with many youth players over the last two decades, one of whom was a Parade All-American and Colorado Gatorade player of the year (my daughter), and another woman who played at the University of Wyoming and was honorable mention All-American.

I am presently on the Museum Advisory Board which I find interesting and even fun at times. I have served on the board of the Longmont (Medical) Clinic and was on the board and then chair of the Longmont United Hospital Ethics Committee for a few years in the 1990's.

Going back several decades, I was a juggler and clown in a Seattle-based circus, called The Floating World Circus, and performed as a busker on the streets of Seattle and Portland. One highlight was juggling with my juggling partner on center stage at the Seattle Kingdome before Peter Frampton performed, in front of 35,000 people in 1977.
