A Proclamation Designating May 6, 2025 As, "Longmont Sister Cities Appreciation Day" In Longmont, Colorado.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

This proclamation designates May 6, 2025 as, "Longmont Sister Cities Appreciation Day" in Longmont, Colorado. Sponsored by the Longmont Sister Cities Association (LSCA) and President Courtney Michelle. Created in 1991, LSCA is an independent non-profit organization that receives some financial support from the Longmont City Council. Although not a City of Longmont department or division, LSCA represents the City during the annual student exchange program and other cultural events throughout the year. Longmont Sister Cities Association runs a student exchange every summer with the three sister cities, Ciudad Guzman, Mexico, Chino, Japan, and the Northern Arapaho, Wind River Reservation.

Longmont became Chino, Japan's official sister city in 1990. Our cities were paired together for our similar character. Both cities live within stunning views of the mountains and have agricultural roots. At the time, both cities were similar in size: around 50,000 residents. Since the beginning of our relationship, Chino and Longmont have participated in over 30 student exchanges, shared insights into new global challenges, and connected the lives of the many people who would otherwise never crossed paths. Mayor Imai and the delegation here to celebrate 35 years of cultural appreciation, opportunity and joy.
