A PROCLAMATION DESIGNATING
JUNE 2025
AS
“LGBTQ+ PRIDE MONTH”
IN LONGMONT, COLORADO

- WHEREAS June is celebrated as LGBTQ+ Pride Month, commemorating the 1969 Stonewall Uprising in New York City, a pivotal event in the movement for LGBTQ+ rights and liberation; and
- WHEREAS, the LGBTQ+ community has made and continues to make significant contributions to the cultural, civic, and economic successes of the City of Longmont and the State of Colorado; and
- WHEREAS, Longmont recognizes that visibility, advocacy, local engagement, and education are vital to creating a community where all individuals can live safely and free from discrimination; and
- WHEREAS, Pride Month is an opportunity to honor the history of the LGBTQ+ rights movement, to reflect on the ongoing struggle for equality, and to celebrate Longmont’s LGBTQ+ community members; and
- WHEREAS, on June 7, 2025, the Longmont Pride Festival will celebrate LGBTQ+ members of the Longmont community, offering an opportunity for people of all identities to come together, show up, and be seen.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Joan Peck, Mayor, by virtue of the authority vested in me and the City Council of the City of Longmont, do hereby proclaim June 2025 as “LGBTQ+ Pride Month” in Longmont, and invite all citizens in the community to use this month to celebrate the importance of LGBTQ+ equality and recognition.
