2 A RESOLUTION OF THE LONGMONT CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE
3 INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND COUNTY OF
4 BROOMFIELD, THE COUNTY OF BOULDER, AND THE CITY OF BOULDER
5 CONCERNING PARTICIPATION IN THE HOME CONSORTIUM

7 WHEREAS, the United States Government, through the National Affordable Housing Act
8 of 1990, has established the HOME Investment Partnerships Act Program (“HOME” or “HOME
9 Program”); and

10 WHEREAS, through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”),
11 the City of Boulder, the City of Longmont, Boulder County, and the City and County of
12 Broomfield (the “Parties”) have formed a HOME Consortium to administer the HOME program
13 as a Participating Jurisdiction; and the City of Boulder is authorized and designated as the Lead
14 Entity of the HOME Consortium; and

15 WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a HOME Consortium Intergovernmental Agreement
16 (“Intergovernmental Agreement”) dated May 13, 2019, to bring additional funds to the region for
17 the purpose of expansion and rehabilitation of the supply of decent, safe, sanitary, and affordable
18 housing and to strengthen partnerships among all levels of government and the private sector; and

19 WHEREAS, the Parties agree to execute an Amended and Restated Boulder-Broomfield
20 Regional HOME Agreement to incorporate regulatory requirements and guidance provided by
21 HUD and replace the Intergovernmental Agreement; and

22 WHEREAS, the Parties agree to cooperate to undertake or to assist in undertaking housing
23 assistance activities for the HOME Program; and

1 WHEREAS, participation in the HOME Consortium will enhance cooperation between
2 jurisdictions and will maximize the use of resources available to local governments to affect the
3 housing-related problems of lower-income people; and

4 NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONGMONT COLORADO;
5 RESOLVES:

6 Section 1

7 Under section 13.7 of the Longmont Home Rule Charter, the Council approves and
8 authorizes the Mayor to sign the intergovernmental agreement referenced in the title of this
9 resolution in substantially the form now before the Council.

10 Section 2

11 The Council repeals all resolutions or parts of the resolutions in conflict with this resolution,
12 but only to the extent of such inconsistency.
