A Proclamation Designating The Week of May 11-17, 2025 As "National Police Week" And Further Designating May 15, 2025 As "Peace Officers' Memorial Day" in Longmont, Colorado.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

This proclamation designates the week of May 11-17, 2025 as " National Police Week" and further designates May 15, 2025 as "Peace Officers' Memorial Day" in Longmont, Colorado. National Police Week occurs every May. In 1962, President Kennedy proclaimed May 15 as National Peace Officers' Memorial Day and the calendar week in which May 15 falls, as National Police Week. Established by a joint resolution of Congress in 1962, National Police Week pays special recognition to those law enforcement officers who have lost their lives in the line of duty for the safety and protection of others. National Police Week is a collaborative effort of many organizations dedicated to honoring America's law enforcement community. Master Police Officer Ryan Douglas, Chaplains James Taylor, Rick Ebbers, Crystal Nunez and Josh Walker will accept the proclamation.
