EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

In 2025, the Dr. MLK, Jr. Planning Committee, Boulder County will celebrate 30 years in the Boulder County community honoring the life and legacy of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. in Longmont on Monday, January 20, 2025, at Silver Creek High School. The theme for 2025 is “Dream Makers, Milestones and Mile Markers. What’s Your Dream?”. Five pillars guide the program: Celebration, Tribute, Education, Service, and Solidarity.

Celebrating the life and legacy of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. on the National Holiday marking his birth helps to bring the history of the civil rights movement into the present. The history of the Jim Crow South is the context both for the progress in equity that has been made, and for the oppression and racism that is alive and active today in our society.
