7	O-2020-52, adopted the City of Longmont Budget for fiscal year 2021; and		
8	WHEREAS the City Council of the City of Longmont passed appropriation ordinance O-		
9	2020-53 and O-2021-05 for the fiscal year 2021, providing for expenditures in the General Fund		
10	in the sum of \$88,903,569, the Water Fund in the sum of \$39,941,525, the Water Construction		
11	Fund in the sum of \$20,521,835, the Police Prevention/Education Fund in the sum of \$0, the Youth		
12	Services Special Revenue Fund in the sum of \$7,800, the Public Safety Fund in the sum of		
13	\$14,531,354, and the Downtown Development Authority Fund in the sum of \$1,643,499; and		
14	WHEREAS the following list shows estimated actual expenditures and encumbrances for		
15	certain funds:		
16	General Fund - \$89,289,300 (original appropriation of \$88,903,569, state grant revenue of		
17	\$8,000, and intergovernmental revenue of \$377,731); and		
18	Water Fund - \$40,639,025 (original appropriation of \$39,941,525, and contribution of		
19	\$697,500 from the fund balance portion of the Water Fund); and		
20	Water Construction Fund - \$20,754,335 (original appropriation of \$20,021,835, additional		
21	appropriation of \$500,000, and contribution of \$232,500 from the fund balance portion of		
22	the Water Construction Fund); and		

1	Police Prevention/Education Fund - \$6,583 (original appropriation of \$0, private donation)	
2	revenue of \$5,083, and contribution of \$1,500 from fund balance portion of the Polic	
3	Prevention/Education Fund); and	
4	Youth Services Special Revenue Fund - \$41,000 (original appropriation of \$7,800, an	
5	local grant revenue of \$33,200); and	
6	Public Safety Fund - \$14,644,010 (original appropriation of \$14,531,354 and federal grant	
7	revenue of \$112,656); and	
8	Downtown Development Authority Fund - \$1,644,999 (original appropriation of	
9	\$1,643,499 and charges for services revenue of \$1,500); and	
10	WHEREAS the Council finds it necessary to make additional appropriations for	
11	unanticipated expenditures required of the City; and	
12	WHEREAS actual and anticipated revenues for the year for certain funds, including	
13	drawing on fund balance, are exceeding revenues estimated in the 2021 Budget in amount	
14	adequate to fund additional appropriations within those funds; and	
15	WHEREAS the Council finds that every contract funded in this ordinance for a charitable	
16	industrial, educational, or benevolent purpose, or with any denominational or sectarian institution	
17	or association, serves a public purpose.	
18	NOW, THEREFORE, according to Sections 9.4 and 9.12 of the Charter of the City of	
19	Longmont,
