

1 D. That Golden and Aggregate require a supply of fully consumable water for uses
2 associated with mining operations pursuant to a substitute water supply plan.

3 E. That the City, Golden, and Aggregate desire to enter into a Temporary Water Supply
4 Agreement for the Irwin-Thomas Project (“Agreement”) to provide fully-consumable
5 water to be supplied by the City for uses associated with mining operations pursuant to
6 a substitute water supply plan and any other necessary approvals that may be required
7 by the Agreement.

8 Section 2

9 The Mayor, acting on behalf of the City, is hereby authorized to execute and deliver the
10 Agreement, in substantially the form now before the City Council.

11 Section 3

12 To the extent only that they conflict with this ordinance, the Council repeals any conflicting
13 ordinances or parts of ordinances. The provisions of this ordinance are severable, and invalidity of
14 any part shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the rest of this ordinance.
