<b>Counseling and Peer Support Services</b>		
In-House Counseling Services: Nicoletti-Flater Associates, LLP.	\$ 88,200.00	<i>Unlimited direct counseling for officers and their immediate family and Peer Support Team clinical guidance. Invoices are billed monthly for services provided.</i>
Counseling services accessed outside the Department of Public Safety. (Providers chosen by individual officer)	\$ 58,800.00	<i>Unlimited direct counseling services for officers and their immediate family using a provider outside Longmont Department of Public Safety. Provider chosen by the officers and reimbursed at a rate comparable to in-house services.</i>

Crisis Intervention Training (CIT) and ongoing support and education for officers	\$ 45,000.00	<i>Longmont Public Safety will enroll 25 officers in CIT training, moving the force to nearly 100 percent CIT preparedness (25 X \$1,800 including travel)</i>
<b>Peer Support Team Training</b>		
Peer Support Team training at the Public Safety Peer Support Association Conference	\$ 10,000.00	<i>Longmont Public Safety will send five members of the Peer Support Team to the PSPSA conference (5 X \$2,000 including travel)</i>
