11	THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONGMONT, COLORADO, ORDAINS:	
12	Section 1	
13	The Council finds:	
14	A. There is a need for the additional resources to provide funding for library services	
15	in the City of Longmont, including but not limited to:	
16	1. The acquisition or construction of a new branch library by a not more than	
17	a 1 mill increase in the City's property tax for not more than 20 years	
18	beginning with tax collection year 2024; and	
19	2. The operation and maintenance of all libraries, including the new branch	
20	library and additional funds for the City's existing library, by	
21	increasing the City's sales and use tax rate from 3.53 percent to 3.68	
22	percent beginning January 1, 2024.	

1	B. The City of Longmont City Council desires to refer the question of	
2	approval of such taxes to the registered electors of the City of Longmont.	
3	Section 2	
4	In this ordinance, ellipses indicate material not reproduced as the Council intends	
5	to leave that material in effect as it now reads.	
6	Section 3	
7	The Council amends section 4.04.130 of the Longmont Municipal Code, by adding any	
8	3 italicized material and deleting any stricken material, to read as follows:	
9	4.04.130 Sales tax levied; allocation of increased tax for open space acquisition	
10	and maintenance and street system maintenance and improvements from special	
11	public improvement funds.	
12	A. There is imposed upon all sales of commodities and services specified in	
13	Section 4.04.080, tax at the rate of 3.6853 percent of the sales price to be	
14	computed in accordance with schedules or systems approved by the finance	
15	director, or designee. Said schedules or systems shall be designed so that no such	
16	tax is charged on any sale of \$0.16 or less.	
17		
18	O. All revenues derived from the fifteen one-hundredths of one cent increase	
19	approved according to Ordinance No. [O-2023] shall be used exclusively to	
20	provide resources to fund the operation and maintenance expenses of all	
21	libraries. The fifteen one-hundredths of one cent increase shall begin January 1,

Section 4

2	The Council amends section 4.04.280 of the Longmont Municipal Code, by adding any
3	italicized material and deleting any stricken material, to read as follows:

4.04.280. - Storage, consumption and use tax levied; allocation of increased tax for open space acquisition and maintenance and street system maintenance and improvements from special public improvement funds.

A. Except as provided separately in subsections F through K of this section for construction equipment, there shall be levied and there shall be collected from every person a tax or excise for the privilege of storing, using, distributing or otherwise consuming any article of tangible personal property purchased at retail from sources outside the corporate limits of the city, subsequent to the effective date of the ordinance codified in this chapter. Such tax shall be payable to and shall be collected by the director of finance at the rate of 3.6853 percent of the price to be computed in accordance with schedules or systems approved by the finance director, or designee. Said schedules or systems shall be designed so that no such tax is charged on any sale of \$0.16 or less.

P. All revenues derived from the fifteen one-hundredths of one cent increase approved according to Ordinance No. [O-2023-__] shall be used exclusively to provide resources to fund the operation and maintenance expenses of all libraries. The fifteen one-hundredths of one cent increase shall begin January 1, 2024.

- To fund the acquisition or construction of a new branch library the City Council may increase the City property tax by not more than 1 mill for not more than twenty years beginning

6 Section 6

Election and Effective Date:

Under section 9.15 of the Longmont Municipal Charter and Article X, Section 20 of the Colorado Constitution, the Council refers this ordinance to the qualified electors of the City for approval at the special City election now scheduled for November 7, 2023. If approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon, it shall become effective when the City Clerk or other designated election official duly files the required certificate of election, or on January 1, 2024, whichever occurs last.

Ballot Title and Question:

The ballot title and question submitted to the electors shall be as follows:

SHALL CITY OF LONGMONT TAXES BE INCREASED \$7,400,000

ANNUALLY IN THE FIRST FULL YEAR AND BY WHATEVER

ADDITIONAL AMOUNTS ARE GENERATED ANNUALLY IN EACH

SUBSEQUENT YEAR FROM A MILL LEVY OF NOT TO EXCEED 1 MILL

(PROVIDED THAT SUCH MILL LEVY MAY BE ADJUSTED TO ACCOUNT

FOR CHANGES IN THE METHOD BY WHICH ASSESSED VALUE IS

DETERMINED) FOR NOT MORE THAN TWENTY YEARS BEGINNING

1	WITH TAX COLLECTION YEAR 2024 TO FUND THE ACQUISITION OR
2	CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW BRANCH LIBRARY AND FROM AN
3	ADDITIONAL CITY SALES AND USE TAX RATE OF .15% BEGINNING
4	JANUARY 1, 2024, TO FUND OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF ALL
5	CITY LIBRARIES, SHALL ORDINANCE O-2023 AUTHORIZING SUCH
6	TAX INCREASES BE APPROVED, AND SHALL THE PROCEEDS OF SUCH

Section 9

Pursuant to Article XX of the State Constitution and the Charter, all State statutes that might otherwise apply in connection with the provisions of this ordinance (including, without limitation, § 31-11-111, C.R.S.) are hereby superseded to the extent of any inconsistencies or conflicts between the provisions of this ordinance and such statutes. Any such inconsistency or conflict is intended by the City Council and shall be deemed made pursuant to the authority of Article XX of the State Constitution and the Charter.
