

ORDINANCE O-2023-

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING 4.08.040 OF THE LONGMONT MUNICIPAL
CODE ON CITY REBATE PROGRAMS FOR INCOME-QUALIFIED RESIDENTS

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONGMONT, COLORADO, ORDAINS:

Section 1

In this ordinance, ellipses indicate material not reproduced as the Council intends to leave that material in effect as it now reads.

Section 2

The Council amends section 4.08.040 of the Longmont Municipal Code, by adding italicized material and deleting stricken material, to read as follows:

4.08.040. - Amounts.

A. Rebates of property tax to qualified applicants shall be determined as follows:

1. Homeowner. The amount of tax paid to the city determined by multiplying the assessed value of the property by the city mill levy in effect for the year the tax was levied;

2. Renter. A sum equivalent to 20 percent of the average monthly rental paid by applicant during the preceding year.

B. Rebates of grocery sales tax to qualified applicants shall be determined as follows:

1. Amount of rebate based on household size:

Number of Household Members	Amount of Grocery Sales Tax Rebate
1	\$78.00
2 people	\$156.00
3 or more people	\$204.00

2. Beginning in 2020, the rebate amount shall be automatically adjusted annually based on the consumer price index (CPI).

C. Rebates of charges for electric services to qualified applicants shall be determined as follows:

1. For each month in the preceding year for which the applicant paid a bill for electric service, the amount shown in this table will be rebated to the applicant, unless subsection C.2 of this section applies. The amount shown in 2025 shall continue in effect until changed.

Year Billed	2023	2024	2025
Rebate per month	\$10.50	\$10.50 \$15.50	\$10.50 \$20.75

2. Applicants who receive the discounted electric rate under chapter 14.32, Rates and Regulations Governing Electric Service, as of December 31, 2018, will continue to receive the monthly discount and are not eligible for this rebate component.

Section 3

This ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 2024.

2 To the extent only that they conflict with this ordinance, the Council repeals any
3 conflicting ordinances or parts of ordinances. The provisions of this ordinance are severable, and
4 invalidity of any part shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the rest of this ordinance.
