6	Section 1
7	In this ordinance, ellipses indicate material not reproduced as the Council intends to leave
8	that material in effect as it now reads.
9	Section 2
10	The Council amends section 4.08.040 of the Longmont Municipal Code, by adding
11	italicized material and deleting stricken material, to read as follows:
12	4.08.040 Amounts.
13	A. Rebates of property tax to qualified applicants shall be determined as
14	follows:
15	1. Homeowner. The amount of tax paid to the city determined by multiplying
16	the assessed value of the property by the city mill levy in effect for the year the
17	tax was levied;
18	2. Renter. A sum equivalent to 20 percent of the average monthly rental paid
19	by applicant during the preceding year.
20	B. Rebates of grocery sales tax to qualified applicants shall be determined as
21	follows:
22	1. Amount of rebate based on household size:

Number of Household Members	Amount of Grocery Sales Tax Rebate
1	\$78.00
2 people	\$156.00
3 or more people	\$204.00

2 2. Beginning in 2020, the rebate amount shall be automatically adjusted 3 annually based on the consumer price index (CPI). C. Rebates of charges for electric services to qualified applicants shall be 4 determined as follows: 5 6 For each month in the preceding year for which the applicant paid a bill 1. 7 for electric service, the amount shown in this table will be rebated to the applicant, unless subsection C.2 of this section applies. The amount shown in 8 9 2025 shall continue in effect until changed.
