A Bill For An Ordinance Amending Chapter 14.04 Of The Longmont Municipal Code On The Windy Gap Surcharge

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Windy Gap Surcharge is a fee collected at the time a building permit is issued to cover the proportional cost of Windy Gap infrastructure from both the parent project and the firming project. The current fee is set to expire at the end of the year, and requires an update both to extend the date and to include the final cost of the Windy Gap Firming Project.

The current fee is \$1,320 for a typical residential water connection, as established in O-2017-83 and extended through 2021 in O-2018-44. This ordinance increases the fee to \$1,620 for a typical residential connection based on the additional investment made in the project.
