SUBJECT/AGENDA TITLE:

A Resolution Of The Longmont City Council Approving An Intergovernmental Agreement With The Colorado Bureau Of Investigation For The Use Of The Criminal Justice Information System For Fingerprint-Based Background Checks For Certain City Positions Where Mandated By Law

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The City accesses Colorado Bureau of Investigations (CBI) – Colorado Justice Information Services (CJIS) for pre-employment background checks for specific City position such as Day Camp personnel as required by law. The City is now required to sign a User Agreement for CBI-CJIS Systems Access for Non-Criminal Justice Agency. This agreement outlines governing standards that the City must adhere to in order to continue to have access to CBI-CJIS. If the City does not sign this agreement and does not adhere to the standards, the City would lose such access, which could result in the inability to hire positions requiring such background information.
