**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

The United States Department of Justice's Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives (ATF) is entering into an agreement with the City of Longmont to use Longmont's Firing Range and Training Center.

**BACKGROUND AND ISSUE ANALYSIS:**

The Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives (ATF) would be allowed to reserve blocks of time in the Firing Range, Simunition Structure, and Classrooms. As part of this agreement, the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives (ATF) has agreed to pay for the use of these buildings and equipment.
