A Resolution Of The Longmont City Council Approving The Boulder County Hazard Mitigation Plan For 2022 Through 2027

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The City of Longmont has participated in joint mitigation planning with the Boulder County Office of Disaster Management to create a comprehensive plan examining threats, hazards, risks and desired mitigation strategies, projects, and programs to lessen the impact of emergencies and disasters in the community. Longmont City Council previously approved the 2021 version of this plan, however this version was not approved and had to be revised requiring an updated approval by the Longmont City Council. The Longmont Annex was not a contributing factor to the previous plan not being approved and changes made to our annex only reflect new information that became available after the original draft was submitted in 2021. An approved Mitigation plan is required to make the City of Longmont eligible for Federal Mitigation Grants
