A Resolution Of The Longmont City Council Approving The First Amendment To The Intergovernmental Agreement Between The City Of Longmont And The State Of Colorado Department Of Public Health And Environment For COVID Surveillance Testing Of Longmont's Wastewater

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Attached is a Resolution for an Intergovernmental Agreement with the State of Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) to conduct surveillance testing for pathogens of concern on the City of Longmont's wastewater. CDPHE has been conducting a wastewater surveillance program for the presence of SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes COVID-19 since August 2020. The attached agreement allows for expansion of that program to include pathogens of concern through July of 2023. The City will be responsible for collecting and preparing for shipment two samples each week. CDPHE will cover the cost of the analyses, courier service and will continue to manage the data and provide a public dashboard.
