A Resolution Of The Longmont City Council Approving The Amendment To An Intergovernmental Agreement Between The City Of Longmont And Colorado Department Of Human Services Office Of Behavioral Health For A Grant To Support The Longmont Public Safety LEAD Program

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

This grant helps to fund the Public Safety LEAD program, which helps community members who struggle with substance use disorder and mental health to avoid jail and instead connect to intensive case management and community based wrap-around services. The LEAD program is a large part of the Public Safety diversion program that works to remove individuals from the criminal justice and emergency medical systems. This funding is for the 2021 State fiscal year.
