EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

This grant provides partial funding for the Public Safety CORE team. The CORE team is a primary response team that consists of a police officer, paramedic, and mental health clinician. They respond together to mental health calls for service. The team provides direct service on-scene along with follow-up services, resource navigation, and refers to the Public Safety case management team as necessary. The CORE team is a key component of the Public Safety diversion model.
