A Resolution Of The Longmont City Council Approving A First Amendment To The Intergovernmental Agreement Between The City And Boulder County For Repair And Remediation Of The Peschel Property From Flooding

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Following the 2013 Flood, the City entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with Boulder County to collaborate on the funding and repair of damage to the Peschel Property (Property), which is jointly owned by the City and the County. Repairs to this property were completed as part of the City's Resilient St. Vrain Project - Sandstone Ranch Reach. The original IGA identified that the City and the County would support a coordinated planning effort to determine the flood recovery needs of the Property and that the City would be the official applicant to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). FEMA flood recovery funds were used for the remediation of the property and design of the improvements were coordinated between the City and the County.

The coordination and work performed resulted in a successful project and this First Amendment to the IGA acknowledges that the coordination between the City and the County has been critical to flood recovery and developing resiliency for the future of the Property. The Amendment stipulates that the ongoing operation and maintenance of the Property will continue in accordance with all applicable existing agreements. The Amendment also states that the parties agree that annexation of the Peschel Property to the City of Longmont is in the best interest of the long-term maintenance of the property including enforcement of applicable regulations. The City agrees to prepare any necessary annexation documentation and the County agrees to support the annexation application.
