# **SUBJECT/AGENDA TITLE:**

A Resolution Of The Longmont City Council Approving The Intergovernmental Agreement Between The City And Boulder County For The Conduct And Administration Of The 2020 General Election To Be Held November 3, 2020

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

In accordance with State Statute, an agreement with Boulder County must be signed by August 25, 2020, in order to conduct a coordinated election with Boulder County in November. Attached is an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Boulder County Clerk and Recorder to provide for the conduct and administration of the coordinated election to be held November 3, 2020. The agreement outlines the responsibilities of both parties and is substantially the same as the agreement used in previous elections.

- 2. Do not adopt the resolution and direct staff to conduct the Special Election separate from the Coordinated Election

Election costs vary. The County Clerk will bill the City for actual charges for labor and materials associated with the City's ballot items. The City Clerk's Office has allocated approximately \$92,000 for election costs in 2020.
