**SUBJECT/AGENDA TITLE:**

**A Resolution Of The Longmont City Council Approving The Intergovernmental Agreement Between The City And Weld County For The Conduct And Coordination Of The November 3, 2020 Election**

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

In accordance with State Statute, an agreement with Weld County must be signed by August 25, 2020, in order to conduct a coordinated election with Weld County in November for the small portion of the City that is in Weld County. Attached is an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Weld County Clerk and Recorder to provide for the conduct and administration of the coordinated election to be held November 3, 2020. The agreement outlines the responsibilities of both parties and is substantially the same as the agreement used in previous elections.

**COUNCIL OPTIONS:**

1. Adopt the resolution approving the agreement
2. Do not adopt the resolution and direct staff to conduct the Special Election separate from the Coordinated Election

**RECOMMENDED OPTIONS:**

**FISCAL IMPACT & FUND SOURCE FOR RECOMMENDED ACTION:**

Election costs vary. The County Clerk will bill the City for actual charges based on the number of electors in City limits in Weld County as per the agreement. The typical election costs for the Weld County portion of the election are very small and average less than \$500. The City Clerk's Office has allocated approximately \$92,000 for election costs in 2020, the bulk of which are Boulder County coordination costs.
