EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

City Council has requested periodic updates on the activities of the Public Safety Diversion Programs. The Crisis Outreach Response and Engagement (CORE) team, our pre-arrest diversion (LEAD) program, the Angel Initiative and the Community Health program were established to address the mental health and substance use issues in our community.
